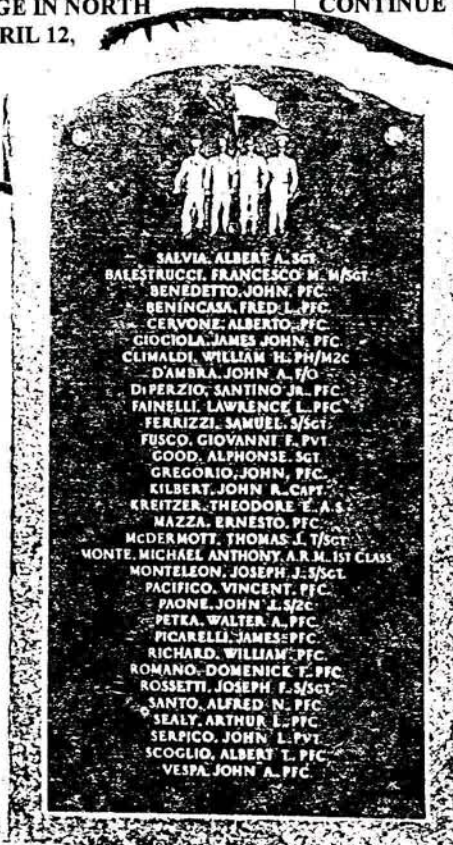

ON MEMORIAL DAY, MAY 30, 1986, GOV. KEAN DEDICATED NEW JERSEY'S FIRST STATE-OPERATED VETERANS CEMETERY. MY WIFE AND I VISITED THE CEMETERY AND SPOKE TO THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND THE CEMETERY COMMITTEE. WITH THE SUPPORT OF GOV. FLORIO AND THE MAJ. GEN. VITO MORGANO, ADJ. GEN. OF VETERANS' AFFAIRS, THE PLAQUE WAS ACCEPTED INTO THE CEMETERY IN 1991. TODAY THE BRONZE PLAQUE IS LOCATED AT THE "BRIGADIER GENERAL WILLIAM C. DOYLE VETERANS MEMORIAL CEMETERY". THE ADDRESS IS ARNYTOWN, WRIGHTSTOWN, NJ. DIRECTIONS -- TAKE ROUTE 537 EAST TO PROVINCE LINE ROAD, THEN A LEFT TURN TO THE CEMETERY, CONTINUE ON ROAD -- CEMETERY ENTRANCE WILL BE ON THE LEFT. THE PLAQUE IS BENEATH THE BELL TOWER IN THE VICINITY
